



Embracing a W.I.P.

"...when people compose, the activities of prewriting, writing, and rewriting do not typically occur in fixed sequence but rather are interwoven with each other in a complex way," (Flower and Hayes 1106)









"Data that support the commentary are deliberately selected to endorse that same commentary," (Morse, 3)





Can be an organizational tool used in later stages of the writing process



It can "Determine if your paper meets its **Y**goal...Discover places to expand on...See where readers might be tripped up," (UW-Madison Writing Center)

The Connection



While the reverse outline may seem to imitate a linear structure, it provides for a less overwhelming way to experiment with moving ideas around.

By diminishing cherry-picking, there can be less "missing perspectives," (Morse, 3). This might provide more leeway for the reorganization of a draft since it would be less confined by a "linear" argument.





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
